Policy: PASRR I, PASRR II and Interfacility Transfers

Preadmission Screening and Resident Review (PASRR) Level I's are required on all clients entering a Medicaid Certified facility. The admitting facility will not receive payment from Medicaid until the PASRR Level I is on file and completed in its entirety with the Office of Healthcare Financing (OHCF).

PASRR Level I will be considered valid for one (1) year unless a change of condition has occurred, in which case a NEW PASRR I should occur at the time of change.

If the PASRR Level I triggers a PASRR Level II (potential for serious Mental Illness (MI) or Mental Retardation (MR) diagnosis), the PASRR II must also be completed prior to admission with a "determination date" from the State of Wyoming prior to admission, for payment moving forward.

The purpose of PASRR II is multifunctional: 1) The assessment of the clients' diagnoses; and 2) The verification of appropriate placement; when a transfer of a client occurs from one facility to another, a NEW PASRR Level II must be completed. Again, this transferring PASRR Level II must be completed prior to admission.

The contents of the PASRR Level II required for determination are:

- PASRR Level I Screening
- PASRR Level II Informed Consent Form
- LT101 Assessment (less than 60 days old)
- Current Medical History and Physical
- Current Drug History (or Comprehensive if MR)
- Progress Notes
- Psychiatric Evaluation (only if on file)
- Psychosocial Evaluation (if you do not already have an evaluation on file for the client, you must order one from a local Community Mental Health Center and include it with the other required documents)

Psychosocial Evaluations will be valid for six (6) months from the date of the evaluation unless a change of condition has occurred, in which case a NEW psychosocial should occur at the time of change.
